FREEDOM OF INFORMATION MODLE PUBLICATION SCHEME FOR MOUNT SURGERY MEDICAL PRACTICE

This Publication Scheme provides a guide to the services and General Practitioners who practice together within the Mount Surgery Medical Practice as required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The document is based on the model publication scheme for general practices produced by the NHS Freedom of Information (FOI) project board and the British Medical Association (BMA).

1. Introduction

This Publication Scheme is a complete guide to the information routinely made available to the public by Drs Burridge, Magdon, Ryell, Jambulingam, Chisholme & Packwood. It is a description of the information about our General Practitioners (GPs) and Practice, which we make publicly available. It will be reviewed at regular intervals and we will monitor its effectiveness.

2. How much does it cost?

The publications are all free unless otherwise indicated. Where there is a charge for providing information the cost will be calculated as set out in each class (please refer to section 7, Cost of Information).

Sometimes some or all of the information cannot be provided and we will explain the reasons why not when this happens.

- The Freedom of Information Act 2000 recognises that members of the public have the right to know how public services are organised and run, how much they cost and how the decisions are made.
- From January 1st 2005 it will oblige the General Practice to respond to requests about information that it holds, and it is recorded in any format and it will create a right of access to that information. Those rights are subject to some exemptions which have to be taken into consideration before deciding what information it can release.
- New environmental information regulations may be introduced as early as 2003. These will enable similar access to environmental information as under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
- Under the Data Protection Act 1998 you are also entitled to access your clinical records or any other personal information held about you and you can Contact your General Practitioner at the Mount Surgery Practice.
